Enticing aromas jump out of the glass with this beautiful Cabernet Sauvignon. Notes of black currant, anise, and cedar intrigue the senses. Flavors of cassis, blackberry, and black cherry coat the palate leading to supple tannins that carry through a lengthy finish. The Double Lariat Cabernet is highly elegant yet accessible for any occasion and any connoisseur.

ESTATE CHEF'S PAIRING

The tannin structure and fruit forward notes pair beautifully with lamb ribeye, smoked beef tenderloin carpaccio and spinach stuffed mushrooms.
