



JAMIESON RANCH — VINEYARDS —



Jamieson Ranch Vineyards, is the southernmost winery in the Napa Valley. The property's 300 acres of gently rolling hillsides and terraced vineyards were formerly part of General Mariano Vallejo's Rancho Suscol in the mid-1800s. Today the ranching tradition continues, with cattle grazing the hillsides, sheep amidst the vines for weed control, and an apiary, from which we source our estate honey.

The unique architecture of Jamieson Ranch Vineyards is reminiscent of a majestic western mountain lodge, replete with soaring ceilings, seating around a cozy

fireplace, an observation gallery overlooking the barrel room and production area, and a spectacular wraparound veranda that affords sweeping views of the Napa Valley and San Pablo Bay.

Jamieson Ranch Vineyards has formed the Light Horse Foundation, dedicated to helping at-risk individuals, particularly those with autism, and supporting other important humanitarian causes. A portion of profits will go to support the Light Horse Foundation.

2013 JRV DOUBLE LARIAT CABERNET SAUVIGNON NAPA VALLEY

*Enticing aromas jump out of the glass with this beautiful Cabernet Sauvignon. Notes of black currant, anise, and cedar intrigue the senses. Flavors of cassis, blackberry, and black cherry delight the palate leading to supple tannins that carry through a lengthy finish. The Double Lariat Cabernet is highly elegant yet accessible for any occasion and any connoisseur. **Production: 7,100 cases***

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2013 REATA THREE COUNTY PINOT NOIR SONOMA/MONTEREY/SAN BENITO

This Pinot Noir is notable for its rich ruby color and notes of cherry, raspberry and pomegranate. Aromas of vanilla fill the glass that lead to a well-structured weight on the pallet. French oak notes lead to a strong finish that lingers on the pallet nicely. A great Pinot Noir for any occasion. Production: 19,355 cases

2012 REATA CHARDONNAY CARNEROS

Brilliant straw yellow in hue, the nose is marked by ripe peach, mango, golden apple, lime, honeysuckle and bay leaf. Gorgeous entry unfolds into flavors of stone fruits and plush tropical fruits. The mouth feel is smooth, the acidity mature and a touch of sweet oak contributes to its depth and complexity. Production: 11,000 cases

2013 LIGHT HORSE CHARDONNAY CALIFORNIA

Vivid straw yellow in color, this expressive Chardonnay features intense fruit aromas of peach, apricot and pineapple. Your palate is enticed with flavors of poached pear, caramel, vanilla and honeysuckle. Complex well integrated oak complements the weight on the mid-palate, leading to a full and well-rounded finish. 2012 LIGHT HORSE CABERNET SAUVIGNON NAPA/LODI/LAKE COUNTY

Intense ruby in color, this Cabernet features a redolent bouquet of cassis, blueberry, plum, vanilla bean, toffee, clove and a touch of tobacco. Delectable berry flavors are supported by refreshing acidity which runs through the mid- palate and melts into a long finish. Soft tannins provide a smooth texture, with a touch of oak contributing appealing spice notes to the wine. Production: 10,000 cases

2013 WHIPLASH RED BLEND CALIFORNIA

35% Zinfandel, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon, 23% Malbec, 17% Petite Sirah/Tempranillo

Vibrant garnet in color, this exotic blend of red varietals exudes aromas of blackberry, plum, blueberry and floral hints of lily. Your pallet is enticed with ripe fruit blended with chocolate notes that lead to fine tannins providing a velvety texture and a substantial mouthfeel. Rich layered notes of French Oak finish this beautiful wine. Production: 3,102 cases.

2013 WHIPLASH ZINFANDEL LODI

This Zinfandel expresses the classic trademarks of the varietal, with its vibrant fruit flavors, full body, sweet oak and touch of spice. An exuberant wine of bold character and unbridled spirit, it serves as a fitting tribute to the extraordinary horse called Whiplash. Production: 4,000 cases
