#### TASTING NOTES

This wine is from a single vineyard in the windswept hills of Sonoma's Carneros, a cool coastal appellation where the Pinot Noir grape reaches its fullest expression. Well-structured and highly aromatic, this eloquent expression of time and place displays signature flavors of raspberry and Bing cherry and French oak-derived notes of vanilla bean and spice.

#### ESTATE CHEF'S PAIRING

This easy-to-love Pinot Noir pairs well with so many dishes! It is particularly delightful with a delicate, poached salmon or duck breast with pomegranate citrus glaze.

**JAMIESON RANCH VINEYARDS** is the southernmost winery in the Napa Valley. The property's rolling hillsides and vineyards were formerly part of General Mariano Vallejo's Rancho Suscol in the mid-1800s. Today, the ranching tradition continues with cattle grazing the hillsides, an apiary, from which we source our estate honey, and our own miniature horses roaming the property.
