### TASTING NOTES

From a single vineyard in the San Benito AVA, this wine derives its character from the cool breezes that funnel in from the Pacific Ocean nearby. With an expansive mouthfeel with structured acidity, this is a balanced and richly colored Pinot Noir. Notes of sweet spices, with bright fruit flavors of cherry and red plum, some earthiness. This wine has a long finish with notes of red fruit and sweet oak.

### ESTATE CHEF'S PAIRING

The lovely acidity of our Pinot Noir makes it the perfect complement to portobello mushrooms or classic French coq au vin. An ideal cheese pairing would be Brie or a milder blue cheese, such as Gorgonzola dolce.

**JAMIESON RANCH VINEYARDS** *is the southernmost winery in the Napa Valley. The property's rolling hillsides and vineyards were formerly part of General Mariano Vallejo's Rancho Suscol in the mid-1800s. Today, the ranching tradition continues with cattle grazing the hillsides and our own miniature horses roaming the property.*
