TASTING NOTES

Known for fine Burgundian varieties such as Chardonnay, Carneros is a cool region characterized by clay-laden soils and the maritime influence of the nearby San Pablo Bay. Rich and viscous yet with a zesty streak of minerality, our Carneros Chardonnay deftly balances rich tropical fruit, luscious oak, a creamy texture and structured acidity.

ESTATE CHEF'S PAIRING

This quintessential Carneros Chardonnay is a natural partner to pork chops with baked apple rings or fresh Alaskan halibut.



JAMIESON RANCH VINEYARDS is the southernmost winery in the Napa Valley. The property's rolling hillsides and vineyards were formerly part of General Mariano Vallejo's Rancho Suscol in the mid-1800s. Today, the ranching tradition continues with cattle grazing the hillsides, an apiary, from which we source our estate honey, and our own miniature horses roaming the property.
