TASTING NOTES

Blending is the winemaker's art, and in this wine we bring together grapes from some of Napa Valley's finest vineyards and appellations. This is a full-bodied, fruit-driven wine with warm flavors of plum, black cherry and fig along with satisfying notes of mocha and toasted coconut. The approachable tannins lead to a finish that is smooth and lasting.

ESTATE CHEF'S PAIRING

Saltimbocca or breaded veal schnitzel with a squeeze of lemon is a delightful pairing with this Cabernet Franc, enhancing the sweet mid-palate of this exceptional wine.



JAMIESON RANCH VINEYARDS *is the southernmost winery in the Napa Valley. The property's rolling hillsides and vineyards were formerly part of General Mariano Vallejo's Rancho Suscol in the mid-1800s. Today, the ranching tradition continues with cattle grazing the hillsides, an apiary, from which we source our estate honey, and our own miniature horses roaming the property.*
