FOUR REINS CABERNET SAUVIGNON TASTING

This fruit-forward Cabernet offers up lovely aromas of blackberry and boysenberry with hints of tobacco and licorice. In the mouth, lush fruit is layered with notes of cherry, chocolate, cinnamon along with traces of leather. This is a balanced Cabernet with delicate tannins and a long lingering finish.

ESTATE CHEF'S PAIRING

Sublime with braised pork shanks, or garlic-rubbed leg of lamb.



ABOUT JAMIESON RANCH VINEYARDS

Jamieson Ranch Vineyards is the southernmost winery in the Napa Valley. The property's rolling hillsides and vineyards were formerly part of General Mariano Vallejo's Rancho Suscol in the mid-1800s. Today, the ranching tradition continues with cattle grazing the hillsides, an apiary, from which we source our estate honey, and our own miniature horses roaming the property.
