TASTING NOTES

A tightly-woven bond between Russian River Valley terroir and craftsmanship defines the layered nuances of this Pinot Noir, a silky blend structured from discriminating batches of the finest coastal fruit. Entwining violets, bright red raspberries and a long, velvety finish, our winemaker weaves a seamless and elegant wine, infused with subtle details—the warp and weft of each vineyard.

ESTATE CHEF’S PAIRING

The acidity and bright fruit notes in this Pinot Noir act as a nice foil for the earthy richness in spring lamb served pink with fresh herbs and vegetables.



JAMIESON RANCH VINEYARDS is the southernmost winery in the Napa Valley. The property’s rolling hillsides and vineyards were formerly part of General Mariano Vallejo’s Rancho Suscol in the mid-1800s. Today, the ranching tradition continues with cattle grazing the hillsides, an apiary, from which we source our estate honey, and our own miniature horses roaming the property.
