TASTING NOTES

Tropical aromas and bright fruit are preserved beautifully through meticulous practices by our winemaker. Night-harvesting by hand, coupled with a fermentation in stainless steel give way to a perfectly crisp wine. A small percentage of barrel fermented Sauvignon Blanc adds a layer of creamy richness to the finish, creating a balanced and complete profile.

ESTATE CHEF'S PAIRING

Silver Spur Sauvignon Blanc is crisp and aromatic, making it the perfect accompaniment to green salads, seafood, poultry, and moderately spicy dishes. Try it with Maryland crab cakes, goat cheese salads, or duck tacos.

JAMIESON RANCH VINEYARDS is the southernmost winery in the Napa Valley. The property's rolling hillsides and vineyards were formerly part of General Mariano Vallejo's Rancho Suscol in the mid-1800s. Today, the ranching tradition continues with cattle grazing the hillsides, an apiary, from which we source our estate honey, and our own miniature horses roaming the property.
