TASTING NOTES

This Sauvignon Blanc is crisp, dry and perfect for a hot day. Notes of guava, apricot, honeysuckle, green apple, lemon zest and candied lemon peel swirl in the glass. These tropical fruit aromas are complimented by floral notes and a grassy character, making this a classic, well-balanced and complex Napa Valley Sauvignon Blanc.

ESTATE CHEF'S PAIRING

Silver Spur Sauvignon Blanc is crisp and aromatic, making it the perfect accompaniment to green salads, seafood, poultry, and moderately spicy dishes. Try it with Maryland crab cakes, goat cheese salads, or duck tacos.

JAMIESON RANCH VINEYARDS is the southernmost winery in the Napa Valley. The property's rolling hillsides and vineyards were formerly part of General Mariano Vallejo's Rancho Suscol in the mid-1800s. Today, the ranching tradition continues with cattle grazing the hillsides and our own miniature horses roaming the property.
